Created by the producers of the famous Church Street Art & Craft Show on Main Street now in its 28th year in Downtown Waynesville, North Carolina.

Heritage seeking tourists will be drawn to the *Main Street Waynesville* celebration where traditional crafts are demonstrated and offered for sale. Music lovers will enjoy tapping their toes to the music of banjos, fiddles and dulcimers while professional cloggers and dancers perform. There will be a variety of events throughout the day for folks of all ages.

In the interest of protecting, preserving and developing *historical and cultural resources*, the *Downtown Waynesville Association* is sponsoring a heritage themed event, providing educational and entertainment opportunities.

Exhibit space will be made available to vendors demonstrating and/or selling in the areas of basket making, weaving, quilting, wood working, wood carving, pottery, painting, blacksmithing, knives, gunsmithing, leatherworking, clock making, soap making, molasses, butter churning, and more.

The day long celebration will also include food vendors featuring delicious and traditional Appalachian food.

DEADLINE: April 1, 2011

Rules & Requirements:

1. Space assignments and set-up procedures will be assigned in May. **Set-up time is 7-9am.** All vehicles must be off the street by 9:30am. **DO NOT take-down before 5 pm. DO NOT LEAVE ANY CARDBOARD!**
2. 8% Sales Tax collection & reporting is responsibility of exhibitor.

3. Booth fee is non-refundable once accepted. There is no rain date and no refund in case of rain. Submission of a commitment form is a contract to abide by the rules set forth.
4. Vendors are responsible for their own equipment, tables, chairs, rain covers, etc. Canopies are encouraged for rain and heat.
5. All applications must be approved for the show. **Space is limited, first-come-first-served basis.**
6. * Demonstrate/Educational all day - fee will be eliminated. Limited demo booths available.
7. * Demonstrate/Sales all day with product sales. Pay only \$50 for one booth, \$75 for two booths.
8. Period Dress is Encouraged.

9. Guideline & Event Rules:

- Exhibit space will be made available to vendors demonstrating/selling authentic Appalachian crafts, in areas of basket making, blacksmithing, gunsmithing, leatherworking, knives, quilting, weaving, pottery, wood working/carving, painting, drawing, clock making, soap making, molasses, butter churning, etc. **ALL ITEMS & PRODUCTS** must be handmade, not purchased.
- Submission of a commitment form is a contract to participate and an agreement to abide by the rules set forth. Set-up procedures, including space locations, will be assigned in May.
- Show directors reserve the right to refuse admittance to the event to any artist whose work is deemed offensive or of questionable taste/authenticity and reserve the right to remove any exhibitor violating the show guidelines.

TO MAKE APPLICATION:

Detach, complete and mail attached application form along with items listed below. NO application will be considered without these items:

- 1) **Application form**, completed and signed.
- 2) **A check** for booth space, made payable to Downtown Waynesville Association.
- 3) **Four clear images** (3 of work, 1 of display) Images can be slides, photos or digital images on CD. If you want your images returned, send a SASE.
- 4) **DEADLINE: Application postmarked by April 1, 2011.** *Notification of acceptance will be made within 2 weeks of receipt of application.*
