PARADE RULES

RULES & RESTRICTIONS:

Applications must be submitted by: November 12, 2021

Absolutely NO THROWING CANDY. You may HAND OUT candy.

Absolutely NO SANTA'S (there should be only one Santa, who arrives in his sleigh at the end of the parade).

NO OVER-SIZED VEHICLES. Parade entires should not exceed 30-feet.

NO OPEN FLAMES OR USE OF PYROTECHNICS.

NO USE OF PROFANE OR OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE OR IMAGES.

THE TOWN OF WAYNESVILLE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY AND/OR REMOVE FROM THE PARADE ANYONE WHO VIOLATES PARADE RULES.

DECORATIONS: Parade entries MUST BE DECORATED. Entries that do not reflect the parade theme - A WINTER WONDERLAND - will not be eligible for the contest.

PARADE ROUTE: The parade starts at First Presbyterian Church on the corner of Walnut and Main Streets, and proceeds south on Main Street ending at Bogart's restaurant (at the intersection of Haywood and Main Streets).

LINE-UP: You will be notified by email of your place in the parade line up no later than November 22. Line-up will begin at 4 p.m. the day of the parade.

DISBAND AREAS: Groups #1- 41: American Legion field
Groups #24-80: Waynesville Middle School
Groups #81-124+ : First Methodist Church parking lot
(corner of Boyd and Tate Streets, across from the public library).

JUDGING & AWARDS: Parade judges will be positioned in front of the Historic Courthouse to judge for First, Second and Third place winners (winners will receive a trophy).

FEES: \$25 for Non-Profit entries / \$40.00 for commercial entries.
